Submission Guidelines

All mediums and scales, large and small, are encouraged – sculpture, clay, glass, fibre, photography, painting, metalwork, carving, printmaking, jewelry and beyond.

All artwork must be of a high quality in their medium. Artwork must be original creations by the artist, and not previously shown at the Smithers Art Gallery.

Artists may submit up to 2 pieces. The curatorial committee - comprised of professional Indigenous artists - will review all submissions for acceptance. The Smithers Art Gallery will not accept work that includes any discriminatory content, cultural appropriation or contravenes copyright law.
